


Welcome to the latest edition of our newsletter.

With a lot of research we have found the exact source of the picture used for Queen Elizabeth 1, but also have found that the original version, used in the late 1800s, was different. Did you know?

Until the middle of the 1800s, the building we now know as the Queen's was not a full-time pub, though beer was probably brewed by the lady of the house and sold there. But the main occupation of the man of the house was as the village tailor, who employed one or more men to assist in the business.

The village shoemaker lived and worked in one of the houses just across Hill Lane.
