Red

- 1 **Pais de Poetas Merlot, Chile** £17.95
Rich, intense aromas and flavours of bramble fruits. Well rounded
- 2 **Sierra Alta Malbec, Argentina** £17.95
Black cherry, ripe plum and hints of chocolate over supple tannins
- 3 **Little Rascal Shiraz, Victoria, Australia** £17.95
Smooth and rich with flavours of ripe plums and black cherries
- 4 **Paternina Monte Haro Rioja, Spain** £20.25
Red fruits, creamy notes and liquorice. Medium bodied, good structure
- 5 **La Chemin de la Serre, Old Vine Carignan, France** £23.95
This deep red, offers delightful aromas of blackcurrant with a spicy twist and a hint of vanilla
- 6 **Armigero Sangiovese di Romagna Riserva, Italy** £26.95
A superb wine from the Emilia-Romagna region. Ruby red with lashings of ripe cherries, dried fruit and spice, light and fruity on the palate
- 7 **Pa Road Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand** £28.95
Soft and savoury with loads of spicy, dark red berry fruit flavours
- 8 **St Emillion Chateau La Croix de Grezard 2012, France** £34.95
A medium bodied Bordeaux, with spicy, dark fruits and herbal notes combined with earthy hints
- 9 **Cantina di Negrar 2013, Amarone della Valpolicella, Italy** £49.95
Intense garnet red in colour, with concentrated sweet fruit aromas of currants, ripe blueberries and cherries, enhanced with a hint of spicy oak. Beautifully balanced on the palate, it is rich, full bodied and complex with a lingering finish
- 10 **Chateau Musar 2006, Lebanon** £59.95
Savoury with hints of tobacco and wild herbs, this overflows with Musar's unique character and flavour

Zesty and refreshing with tropical fruit flavours
- 12 **Roberts & Reeves Chardonnay, Australia** £17.95
Generous and vibrant with ripe tropical fruit flavours
- 13 **Villa Benizi Pinot Grigio, Italy** £17.95
Citrus fruits on the nose with a refreshing palate of fresh apple and pear
- 14 **Pa Road Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** £20.25
Tropical, ripe mandarin and citrus on the palate with a zesty freshness
- 15 **Picpoul de Pinet, France** £22.95
Elegant lemon bouquet. Its flavour delivers on this promise with lifted citric notes, balanced acidity and a crisp refreshing finish
- 16 **Miopasso Fiano, Italy** £25.95
Delicate floral, yellow peach and candied orange aromas, lead to a lovely purity of lime and citrus fruit
- 17 **Zapaller Riesling Riserva 2016, Chile** £27.95
This Riesling is a fresh and perfumed wine with aromas of citrus, grapefruit, lime, apple and apricot
- 18 **Petit Chablis Domaine d'Elise 2016, France** £30.95
The tangy, fresh citrus notes are beautifully supported by layers of warm rich fruit. Lighter style than its broader richer sibling Chablis
- 19 **Le Maree Pouilly Fumee 2016, France** £35.95
Aromatic and floral with intricate zesty fruits and a dry, flinty finish

- 20 **Villa Benizi Pinot Grigio Blush, Italy** £17.95
Delicate aromas of wild strawberry, apple and honeysuckle.
- 21 **Compass Point White Zinfandel, California** £17.95
Lively & refreshing flavours of strawberry and juicy watermelon.
- 22 **Maison Ventenac Cuvee D'Aure Rose, France** £24.95
A dry rosé with crushed cranberries and cherries.
