- 1 **Pais de Poetas Merlot, Chile** £19.95  
Rich, intense aromas and flavours of bramble fruits. Well rounded
- 2 **Sierra Alta Malbec, Argentina** £19.95  
Black cherry, ripe plum and hints of chocolate over supple tannins
- 3 **Little Rascal Shiraz, Victoria, Australia** £19.95  
Smooth and rich with flavours of ripe plums and black cherries
- 4 **Rioja Santiago Crianza, Spain** £22.25  
Soft, fruity with a hint of oak aging and a long lingering finish
- 5 **La Chemin de la Serre, Old Vine Carignan, France** £23.95  
This deep red, offers delightful aromas of blackcurrant with a spicy twist and a hint of vanilla. An excellent red with good fruit balance and structure
- 6 **Armigero Sangiovese di Romagna Riserva 2017, Italy** £26.95  
A superb wine from the Emilia-Romagna region. Ruby red with lashings of ripe cherries, dried fruit and spice, light and fruity on the palate
- 7 **Pa Road Pinot Noir 2019, Marlborough, New Zealand** £34.95  
Soft and savoury with loads of spicy, dark red berry fruit flavours
- 8 **St Emillion Chateau La Croix de Grezard 2016, France** £36.95  
A medium bodied Bordeaux , with spicy, dark fruits and herbal notes combined with earthy hints
- 9 **Guerrieri Rizzardi 3 Cru 2014, Amarone, Italy** £54.95  
Rich, robust and full bodied – an excellent example to partner rich red meat dishes
- 10 **Chateau Musar 2013, Lebanon** £59.95  
Savoury with hints of tobacco and wild herbs, this overflows with Musar's unique character and flavour

Refreshing and zesty lime leaf notes, with a crisp, balanced finish
- 12 **Santa Carolina Chardonnay, Central Valley, Chile** £19.95  
Tropical fruit flavours of pineapple and banana, with refreshing acidity
- 13 **La Delfina Pinot Grigio, Italy** £19.95  
Citrus fruits on the nose with a refreshing palate of fresh apple and pear
- 14 **Pa Road Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** £22.25  
Tropical, ripe mandarin and citrus on the palate with a zesty freshness
- 15 **Picpoul de Pinet 2021, France** £23.95  
Elegant lemon bouquet. Its flavour delivers on this promise with lifted citric notes, balanced acidity and a crisp refreshing finish
- 16 **Vega-Reina Verdejo 2019, Spain** £26.95  
Citrus fruit flavours with a hint of herbs. Round in the mouth with crisp and refreshing acidity
- 17 **Val do Xuliana Albarino 2020, Spain** £30.95  
Beautiful yellow colour with high intensity, very fruity and floral, fresh and clean, with hints of peach and apricot. Great with seafood
- 18 **Petit Chablis Domaine d'Elise 2019, France** £34.95  
The tangy, fresh citrus notes are beautifully supported by layers of warm rich fruit. Lighter style than its broader richer sibling Chablis
- 19 **La Mariee Pouilly-Fume 2018, France** £38.95  
Aromatic and floral with intricate zesty fruits and a dry, flinty finish

Light and crisp with juicy fresh raspberry and strawberry fruit
